## Please sign this **petition in OBJECTION to the:**

proposed Cement Factory and Brick moulding plant on one side of Bryden Country School (Plot 8 Eastbourne) and on the other side of Bryden Country School, (Lambourne Estate) proposed expansion of the Limestone Quarry mine. Land is already being cleared.

## The objection is based on the following-

- 1. Proximity to the school of both sites wedging the school between two industrial zones.
- 2. Health risks to all children and staff possibility of eye, and skin irritation as well as respiratory challenges both short and long term.
- 3. The knock-on effect on enrolment with Bryden Country School losing its "country school" standing if it has a cement factory on one boundary and an active limestone quarry mine on the other.
- 4. Noise pollution from extended blasting, mining activities, heavy vehicles and machinery.
- 5. General dust as well as exposure to cement and quarry dust.
- 6. Contamination of surrounding groundwater, dam on Lambourne farm, smaller waterways and pools and through runoff into Mupfure River
- 7. Degradation of the environment.
